The Bridge Training and Development is a land-based alternative education provider on a four acre site at Hanley Swan, near Malvern - an independent school registered with the Department of Education. The Bridge is a charity run educational provision and was established in 2007 with the aim of engaging children and young people in learning. Qualified staff work with individual or small groups of students on a bespoke programme. The charity also works with groups of students from Primary and Secondary Schools. Post 16 students can attend where additional funding is available, if they have an Education, Health and Care Plan or are a looked after child/young person.
